

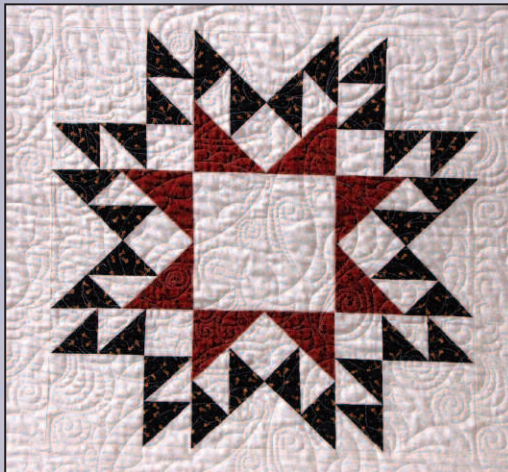
QUILTING AND OTHER SERVICES

Dream Catchers Quilting offers a wide variety of professional quilting services for quilts up to 114" wide, including:

- **Hundreds of perfect Edge-to-Edge quilting designs by Statler Stitcher** which are designs that cover the entire quilt, regardless of quilt pattern, borders or sashing. The pattern is repeated several times throughout each row and is excellent for quilts that will be loved and used for generations.
- **Border to Border Quilting** which combines an Edge-to-Edge design in the body of the quilt with a complementary design for the borders.
- **Custom Quilting** incorporates separate designs into the individual pieces of the quilt, such as the blocks, sashing, setting triangles and borders.
- **Heirloom Quilting** introduces a variety of different background textures to enhance your custom quilt.
- **Binding and Other Services** including half binding, full binding, basting and additional services to prepare your quilt top and backing for longarm quilting.

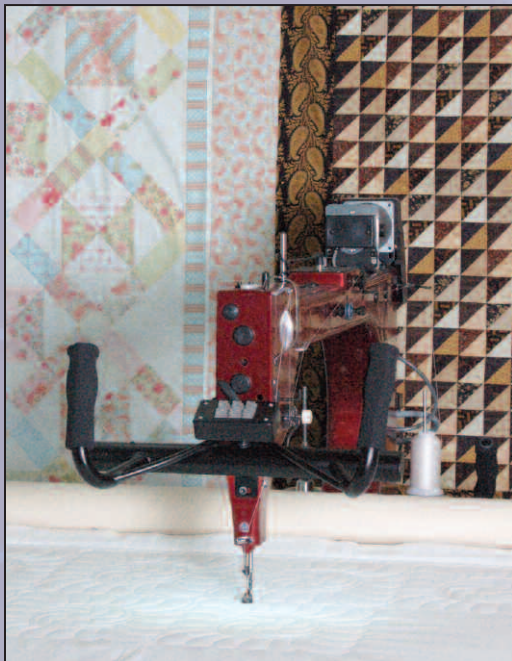

WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM DREAM CATCHERS QUILTING?

When we receive your quilt, we will give you an estimated date you can expect to receive your finished quilt. We'll also email you an invoice with the actual cost of service.

We accept credit card payment via PayPal, personal check, money order or bank draft to Dream Catchers Quilting.

PREPARING YOUR QUILT TOP

- **Press the back of your quilt top well.** Check all of your seams—be sure that none are coming apart, that they are pressed flat to the back and facing the desired directions. Be sure your quilt top is square.
- **Trim off all trailing threads from the back of your quilt top.** Dark thread can show through any light colored fabrics on your quilt top and detract from the beauty of your finished quilt.
- **Stay-stitch 1/4" from the outside edge around the entire perimeter of your quilt top.** This prevents seams from popping open.
- **Measure the center of the top vertically, then the outside edges vertically.** If there is more than 1/2" difference, your quilt might have tucks when quilted. Check the same measurements horizontally.

PREPARING YOUR QUILT BACKING

- **Remove all selvages from seams and edges.** Press the backing well. If the print is directional, pin a piece of paper to the top edge.
- **Be sure the backing is as square as possible.** The quilt won't load properly if it isn't square. Straighten the edges as much as possible.
- **If the backing is pieced, stay-stitch 1/4" from the outside edge around the perimeter.** This prevents seams from popping open.
- **Your batting and backing must be 5" larger than your quilt top on all sides.**

Following these simple instructions prevents extra charges for prep work.

Additional Services \$12.00/hour including piecing quilt backing, stay-stitching, repairs and other minor changes you pre-approve.

We recommend and stock a wide variety of batting choices from Quilter's Dream. Choices include Cotton Select, Cotton Request, Cotton-Poly Blend, Poly Select and Wool. They range in price from \$8.60/yard to \$14.00/yard, up to 93" wide.

If you are unsure of which batting is the best choice for your quilt, we are happy to recommend one for you.
